WHAT IS?

Main Idea

Definition: Main idea is what the story is mostly about.

- Some examples include:
boy meets girl and they fall in love; taking revenge for a wrong; hero's quest

Topic

Definition: a single word or two about the main idea of a story

Kinds of Conflict

Person vs. Person
Person vs. Society
Person vs. Fate
Person vs. Nature
Person vs. Self

WHAT IS THEME?

Definition: Theme is the message conveyed by a text that applies to multiple other texts and is a statement about life.

- It cannot be described in a single word
- It implies a conflict about the main idea

EXAMPLES

Topic	Main Idea	Theme
Love	A boy meets a girl and they fall in love, but there are obstacles. Person vs. Person Conflict	Love can overcome many obstacles in a boy meets girl story.
Justice	A black man is put on trial for a crime in <u>To Kill A Mockingbird</u> . Person vs. Person or Person vs. Society Conflict	Justice isn't always served in a corrupt society, but knowledge about injustice can change the world.
Coming of Age	The main character faces negative peer pressure and holds to the values and morals of society. Person vs. Self and/or Person vs. Society	It's difficult to face adversity, but holding to one's truth is the best path.
